
This week, we have had new interactive panels installed school-wide to replace our older interactive whiteboards and projectors. The new technology is an all in one panel, without the issues of projector lamps and fading screens. Our final board will be installed in the hall in the next week or so. This one is much larger and will be installed with a bracket which allows it to be raised and lowered for the audience. The cost of purchase and installation of these panels in 2018 is in the vicinity of \$60 000. This doesn't include the five panels previously installed. Our FITNESSATHON fundraising has supported this purchase.

With the removal of the old boards, we will be doing rectification work to the walls each Tuesday. On a given day, your child's class may be working in either the computer lab or hall to allow this work to take place. All disruption will be kept to a minimum.

Years 5 and 6 students will be fundraising in the coming weeks for both the Year 6 Farewell and the Year 6 gift to the school. Information should have come home about the fete and cake stall. Please support our students in their efforts.

Over the last two years, the students have performed two musicals. In, future, we plan to do a musical every two years, which means that our next musical will be held in 2019. 
HEAR FROM A HOST MUM

PEER SUPPORT

We introduced a 3 step model this week to encourage resilient responses; Pause, Plan, Proceed.

The children take part in an activity to identify their feelings and the immediate effects on their bodies such as butterflies in their stomachs. The normalcy of feelings is acknowledged and the importance of being proactive is stressed. The children learn that pausing when they are emotional is helpful. They can do this by being still, taking a deep breath or counting to ten. Pausing gives children space to see a situation more accurately before planning a response.

Ask your child to describe the 3 steps of the model and what is involved in each one.




